Profile of skills and competences

A qualified bricklayer has worked with and is experienced in the following disciplines:

- 1) bricklaying techniques;
- 2) flooring and tiling;
- 3) drawings;
- 4) roofing; and
- 5) scaffolding.

A qualified bricklayer is able unsupervised to carry out and use ordinary work disciplines, techniques, materials and tools in relation to the fields of work mentioned above and to carry out bricklaying assignments unsupervised in work relating to the construction of new buildings, urban regeneration, restoration and repair of buildings.

The education and training programme includes two optional special subjects: basic building restoration and advanced building restoration.

Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate

Bricklayers work with brickwork walls, roofs, jointing and rendering, facade cladding, tiling and flooring.

Duration and mode of education and training

The total duration of the education and training programme varies between 3 years and 5 month(s) and 3 years and 11 month(s), with 55 weeks of formal education and training and 122-148 weeks of on-the-job training.

Danish vocational education and training programmes are alternating programmes, which means that the education and training activities alternate between education and training at a school and on-the-job training in an enterprise.

Level of certificate

The training programme is a full vocational education and training programme, equivalent to level 3 in the Isced system (Isced 1997).

Access to the next level of education/training

The education and training described in this certificate gives access to level 4 (Isced) education and training in Denmark.
